GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

This is a ten (10) month post-secondary non-instructional faculty position. Applicants appointed to this position will be assigned a faculty rank consistent with the College ranking system.

- Collaborates in maintaining and developing the library website.
- Serves as database manager for the automated library system including the administration, cataloging, circulation, Online Public Access Catalog (OPAC), and library portal modules.
- Catalogs and classifies print and non-print materials using the automated library system.
- Manages the circulation services of LRC.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Public Law 99-0603 (8 USC Section 1324A) requires the Government of Guam to verify the identity and work eligibility of all newly hired employees. All new employees shall be required to provide any one or a combination of the following and or other documents as m ay be required: Original Birth Certificate; U.S. Passport; Naturalization Card; Alien Registration Card with photograph; original Social Security Card; or other proof of work eligibility.

VETERANS PREFERENCE:

Applicants claiming veteran's preference are required to provide Proof of Eligibility for Veterans Preference Credit. Those claiming Compensable Disability are required to provide a copy of a letter from the Veterans Administration.

EDUCATION:

Applicants claiming degrees or credit hours are <u>required</u> to provide a copy of their college transcript. Transcripts from institutions outside the U.S. <u>must be</u> accompanied by a Comprehensive Course-by-Course Report by a National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES) member organization <u>www.naces.org.</u>

PRE-EMPLOYMENT MEDICAL EXAMINATION AND TUBERCULOSIS TESTING:

All applicants accepting employment with Government of Guam-Guam Community College must take and pass a pre-entry Physical Examination and Tuberculosis Testing as a condition of continued employment. Expenses for the physical medical examination and tuberculosis test must be paid for by the applicant.
